And a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice came out of the cloud,

“This is my beloved Son; listen to him.”

And suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anyone with them but Jesus only.

MARK · Seeing Jesus Clearly ✨

“Listen to Him”

Week 12 Text: Mark 9:2–29

Big Idea:

The glory of Jesus calls us to listen to Him, and the mercy of Jesus invites us to bring Him our honest _____.

1. Jesus Reveals His _____.

Mark 9:2–4

Key Truth:

The cross does not mean Jesus lacks glory; the mountain shows us the glory of the One who is going to the cross.

Notes:

The transfiguration is not Jesus becoming something He was not. It is Jesus revealing something that has been true all along. Moses and Elijah appear with Him, showing that the Law and the Prophets bear witness to Jesus.

2. Jesus Corrects Our _____.

Mark 9:5–6

Key Truth:

Even sincere religious responses can misunderstand Jesus if they do not listen to Him.

Notes:

Peter wants to build three tents. He may be trying to preserve the moment, honor Jesus, Moses, and Elijah, or connect the scene to Israel’s tabernacle traditions. But Mark tells us Peter did not know what to say because he was terrified.

3. The Father Commands Us to _____.

Mark 9:7–13

Key Truth:

Jesus is not one voice among many; He is the beloved Son we must listen to.

Notes:

The cloud signals God’s presence. The Father says, “This is my beloved Son; listen to him.” Moses and Elijah disappear, and the disciples see Jesus only. The Law and the Prophets point to Him, but Jesus stands supreme.

4. Jesus Receives Honest _____.

Mark 9:14-29

Key Truth:

Weak faith is still faith when it brings its weakness to Jesus.

Notes:

The father’s prayer is honest: “I believe; help my unbelief!” He does not hide his uncertainty or pretend his faith is stronger than it is. He brings his faith and unbelief to Jesus.

Listen to the glorious _____, and bring Him your honest _____.
